

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

LAWEA WORKSHOPS

General Definitions

These terms and conditions are valid for every person registered as a delegate, willing to attend the Workshop of LAWEA “Supply Chain Opportunities for Latin America” going to be held in Huatulco, Oaxaca, Mexico, during the dates of: April 29-30, 2010.

The Latin American Wind Energy Association (LAWEA) will be hereinafter referred to as the “conference organizers”

Registrations

Only fully completed registration forms will be accepted.

The registration fee includes all the sessions of the Workshop’s program.

If the payment has not been received after the deadline indicated, the registration will be cancelled.

If the maximum delegate capacity is reached, the organizers reserve the right to refuse additional registrations.

Payments

The registration fee must accompany all conference registrations.

Payments should be made in advance, in US dollars or Mexican pesos (valued depending on the exchange rate of the invoicing date), using a credit card or by bank transfer.

In most cases, the credit card will be charged in US dollars. Should the card be charged in another currency, the delegate will be informed about this prior to the transaction.

Personal cheques or company cheques are not accepted.

Please note, all bank fees and money transfer costs must be prepaid by the transmitter.

Registration name change

A handling fee of US 20 dollars will be charged for every name change to an existing registration. A new registration form for the substitute delegate should NOT be submitted. Name changes will only be accepted by phone, email or fax indicating the new and old names only until March 30, 2010.

Cancellation Policy

In the case of the cancelation of any registration, LAWEA will no refund the costs covered previously by the delegate.

Cancellation of the Conference

In the event that the conference cannot be held or is postponed due to events beyond the control of the conference organizers (force majeure) or due to events which are not attributable to wrongful intent or gross negligence of the conference organizers, they cannot be held liable by delegates for any damages, costs, or losses incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodation costs, financial losses, etc.

Under these circumstances, the conference organizers reserve the right to either retain the entire registration fee and to use it for a future conference, or to reimburse the delegate after deducting costs already incurred for the organization of the conference and which could not be recovered from third parties.

Modification of the Program

AWEA is committed to provide the discussion and study of issues and cases presented by speakers with great experience at this event. Any change, alteration or cancellation in this program will not be caused by the organizers, but for unpredictable or force majeure reasons.

The conference organizers reserve the right to modify the program, which is published as an indication only.

Data Protection and Sharing of Contact Details

LAWEA will collect and store all personal data for the preparation and execution of the Workshop. Data protection is warranted.

In addition, the IAS periodically shares contact details of delegates with third parties that may use these details to contact delegates regarding activities at the conference or other communications which may be of interest. Therefore data might be passed on to third parties unless otherwise explicitly indicated by the delegate in the registration form.
